

# Tournament Regulations for the 3rd Super College Cup

## 1. Objective:

To promote the game of bridge nationwide and allow bridge enthusiasts to relive their fond memories of the College Cup, we are proud to host this tournament.

## 2. Organizer:

Chinese Taipei Contract Bridge Association (CTCBA)

## 3. Sponsor:

## 4. Venue:

Taipei International Bridge Center

(B1, No. 31, Alley 7, Lane 217, Sec. 3, Zhongxiao E. Rd., Da' an Dist., Taipei City)

## 5. Tournament Dates:

July 10 to July 12, 2026 (Friday to Sunday, 3 days).

## 6. Team Formation & Eligibility:

Each team shall consist of 4 to 6 players.

- **(1) Alumni Teams:** Registered under a specific college/university. All team members must be alumni (graduates or attendees) or current students of that institution. Multiple teams from the same school are allowed. The team name must include the name of the school (e.g., TKU Gang, NCHU Law, NTU BTU, etc.).
- **(2) Mixed-School Teams:** Teams may consist of players from different schools, with a maximum of three different schools per team. Members must be alumni or current students of their respective schools. The team name must include the names of the represented schools.
- **(3) Overseas College Teams:** The team must have 4 or more non-Taiwanese players. Mixed-school combinations are allowed. The team name must include the school name(s).

## 7. Registration Method:

- (2) The tournament is limited to 36 teams. Registration is generally on a first-come, first-served basis; however, priority will be given to Alumni Teams, Overseas College Teams, and Organizer's Invited Teams. Remaining spots will then be filled by Mixed-School Teams in the order of their registration.

## **8. Registration Deadline:**

From now until Friday, June 26, 2026.

## **9. Entry Fee:**

- **1. Amount:** NT\$ 5,000 per team. Discounts or waivers are available based on the following criteria:
  - (1) CTCBA members who have paid their annual membership fee for the current year will receive a discount of NT\$ 200 per person.
  - (2) If a team has 3 or more current students, the team fee is NT\$ 3,000. (Students must email relevant student ID/proof to [ctcba886@gmail.com](mailto:ctcba886@gmail.com) to claim this discount).
  - (3) Free entry if a team has 3 or more female players.
  - (4) Free entry for Overseas College Teams.

- **3. Payment Deadline:**
  - (1) Payment must be completed no later than the registration deadline. For bank transfers, the timestamp of the transfer will be used as the proof of time.
  - (2) Teams failing to pay the entry fee by the deadline will be considered unregistered.
- **4. Cancellation & Refund Policy:**  
If a registered and paid team cannot participate, a cancellation request must be submitted to the Association by July 3, 2026. A refund will be issued after deducting related

administrative fees. No refund requests will be accepted after this date.

**10. Tournament Format:**

- **Days 1 & 2:** Qualifying Swiss Teams. The top 8 teams will advance to the Finals.
- **Day 3:** The 8 finalists will play a complete Round-Robin for the Main Event. The remaining teams will play in the Consolation Event (7 rounds of Swiss Teams).

*Note: A winning match bonus of NT\$ 500 per match will be awarded for victories in the last two rounds of both the Qualifying Swiss and the Consolation Swiss.*
